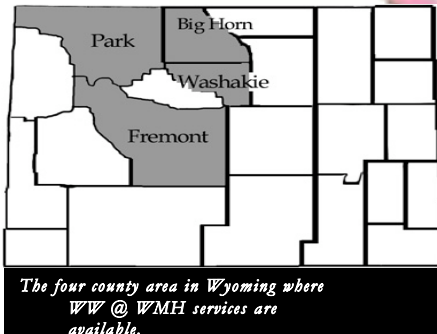


Women's Wellness at WMHP

Fact Sheet-- To improve the health status of women through the assurance of high-quality primary and preventive health care services.

What kind of program is it? *The Women's Wellness at Wyoming Migrant Health program is a grant funded program that provides navigation for wellness services for women who are uninsured and cannot afford to pay for annual breast and cervical cancer screening. In addition to navigation, this program provides 1:1 and group self breast exam education to women enrolled in the program.*

The program is administered by the Wyoming Health Council in Park, Washakie, Big Horn and Fremont Counties, through clinics located in Powell, Worland, Greybull, and Riverton.



Who qualifies for this program? Any woman who is uninsured and cannot afford to pay for her annual exam(s).

Why do women need navigation?

Unfortunately women are hesitant to have their annual screening done even when they have the money to pay for it. It is common that women who need help paying for screening services are reluctant to ask for it. With navigation our program is able to assist women through this process.

provides 1:1 and group education on women's health issues along with "how to perform a self breast exam." Clients get to choose whether they prefer to have 1:1 or group setting for the educational piece.

- ❖ **Assistance with the Application Process:** Program Administrative Assistant/Outreach Workers provide 1:1 assistance in filling out application and coordinating care to each and every client enrolled in our program.
- ❖ **Coordinating Appointments:** Administrative Assistant coordinates appointments with clients' schedules helping them to set up an appointment that is with the participating provider of their choice along with a time that fits the client's schedule.
- ❖ **Gas Vouchers for Travel:** Administered on an "as needed basis".
- ❖ **Reminder Letters/ Phone Calls/ Appointment Cards:** Tracking of appointments and sending out notices in a timely manner.
- ❖ **Case Management and follow-up care:** The program nurse oversees each client ensuring follow up care.
